

Species List

The Claridon species list is compiled from surveys done from 1978 through 2004. While scholars of the prairie differ on what is a prairie species, this list of over 100 reflects the content of seven Claridon prairie surveys. Including all plants found during these surveys there were over 220 species located in this mile-long strip. Species noted on the Green Camp list are the result of casual observation.
