Heritage Hall Auditorium - 169 E. Church Street

Learn about Marion's links to the Underground Railroad which helped escaped slaves travel on their journey to freedom. Visit the new Heritage Hall exhibit of "On the Right Track: How Rail Encouraged Growth in Marion."

July 14 - "Log House Follies"

Log House at Marion County Fairgrounds

While life on the early frontier of Marion certainly had its difficulties, there was still time for fun. Learn about games and other entertainment that pioneer children would have enjoyed while participating in a variety of fun activities.

July 21 - "Huber Power"

Huber Museum - Marion County Fairgrounds (Located at north end near Coliseum)

Marion County has long been known for its rich agricultural heritage and productive farms. Explore how farming has changed over the past 100 years and the role that Huber Manufacturing played.

July 28 - "To & Fro - The Biome Show"
