## Volunteer

### *There are many ways to Volunteer with MCHS*

*Docents (tour guides)*- able to work when the museum is open and/or lead group tours of the museum or other MCHS holdings, such as the Log House and The Linn School. Work once a month or as often as you wish.

*Gift Shop*- able to work when the museum is open and collect admission fees from incoming visitors, Assist with sale of items in the Gift Shop.

*Housekeeping* -Light work dusting, tidying exhibits, cleaning office & public areas of the museum or other MCHS holdings. Caring for the landscaping and natural areas around the Heritage Hall building.

*Artifact Care / Archiving* - Computer cataloging of artifacts. Simple artifact cleaning, numbering, and storage tasks.

*Historical Research* - Conduct research in response to inquiries about Marion County history.

*Exhibit Creation* - Assist the director in developing exhibits and with research relating to the exhibits.

*Desktop Publishing* - Assist director with newsletter & other publications.
